No refrigerators, dehumidifiers or air conditioners. No mattresses or car seats.

Residents in need of a Curbside Electronic Recycling Collection please contact Roy Strom Refuse Removal Service at (708) 344-5000 to schedule a collection. **Do not place electronic items at the curb until the day of your scheduled electronics day collection.** Please have items out by 7:00AM on the day of your scheduled electronics collection day. Payment for collection will be made over the phone with a credit card and will be charged upon collection.

Televisions & Computer Monitors

Computer Monitors & Television under 36"	\$25.00 per item
Televisions 36" or greater	\$35.00 per item

Electronic Items

E-Waste Bundle (Plastic or Paper Grocery Bag)	\$15.00 per bag
Household Electronic Items	\$25.00 per item

Items Accepted for Electronics Recycling: Televisions, printers, computers, computer monitors, laptops, gaming devices, fax machines, scanners, hard drives, radios, copy machines (under 50 lbs), cell phones, keyboards, extension cords, telephones, cameras, cables, household appliance, VCR, music players, microwaves, toasters, alarm clocks hair dryers, any other electronic items with a cord, household batteries.

Items Not Accepted for Electronics Recycling: Large appliances, vacuum cleaners, hazardous waste, chemical waste, light bulbs, CFL light bulbs, car batteries, any battery over D size, gas powered engines, smoke detectors.
