**KEYSTONE BATTING CAGES PROJECT
(CONCRETE)**

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed written bids for the River Forest Park District's **2022 Keystone Park Batting Cages Project**, shall be received until 10:00 a.m. local time, August 4, 2022, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Specifications are available at www.rfparks.com, About Us, Bids, starting July 8, 2022. This is a State of Illinois/Cook County prevailing wage project with a certified payroll to be turned into the park district.

Ten percent (10%) Bid Surety is required on this project. The successful contractor must be able to provide a satisfactory Performance Bond, Labor and Material Bond, and required proof of insurance within ten (10) days of the award of the contract.

The Board of Commissioners of the River Forest Park District reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive any technicalities or formalities which it deems to be in the best interest of the District.

All work must be warranted for one (1) years from date of acceptance.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Scope of Work: Follow plans and details as provided. The project shall consist of the following: providing all labor and materials to excavate, install compacted gravel base, pour/finish concrete, and backfill with topsoil along the edge.

The contractor is responsible for the restoration to any damaged park facilities and properties.

Specifications:

1. Excavate and area 64'-6" x 32'-9" x 7" deep. The adjacent sidewalk will be used as the bench mark as grade. Note: After excavation, the fence contractor will be allowed to dig and install 27'-3" OG galvanized posts per the plans before the gravel base is installed.
2. Gravel Base: 4" compacted limestone.
3. Concrete:
 - a. 5" at 6 bag mix.
 - b. 10-guage wire mesh
 - c. 1/2" expansion joint at the intersection of each post
 - d. Broom finish.

Qualifications of Contractors: This project is open to all qualified contractors who have completed at least two (2) similar applications completed by said contractor that have been in service a minimum of two (2) years; and supply the locations, dates completed.

Completion of Schedule: The contractor shall begin this project on August 29, 2022, and complete this project on or before September 30, 2022.

Prevailing Wage: The contractor must pay the prevailing wage for each trade involved in this project as specified by the State of Illinois Department of Labor.

Guarantee: The successful contractor shall guarantee the work specified herein against defective materials or faulty workmanship for a period of one (1) year following the date of acceptance by the Park District.

Insurance Requirements: The successful bidder shall file with the Park District a certificate of insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 for general and automobile liability. Workers Compensation Insurance shall be provided in accordance with State law. The **River Forest Park District** shall be named as an additional insured on all policies affecting the contract at no extra expense to the District.

Withdrawal of Bids: Bids must be firm for sixty (60) days after opening.

Right Reserved By The Park District: The District reserves the right to waive any informality and/or reject any or all proposals when, in the opinion of the District, such action serves the best interests of the District. Unless proposals are rejected, the contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible, qualified proposal.

COMMENTS

1. Contractor is responsible to contact JULIE for utility locate. The Park District will be responsible for locating underground security light and athletic field light utilities.
2. Access to the project site is limited, via Central Avenue. The contractor will be required to place plywood board protection over the grass. The contractor is responsible for all damages to park grounds and facilities.
3. The Park District is responsible to remove and stumps grind all trees that are currently located in the project area.

PROPOSAL FORM

The undersigned proposed to furnish all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and perform all necessary requirements for The Depot Improvements as specified in accordance with the attached conditions and specifications, and at the terms and schedule prices herein given. The **River Forest Park District** reserves the right to award any or all items in its own best interests.

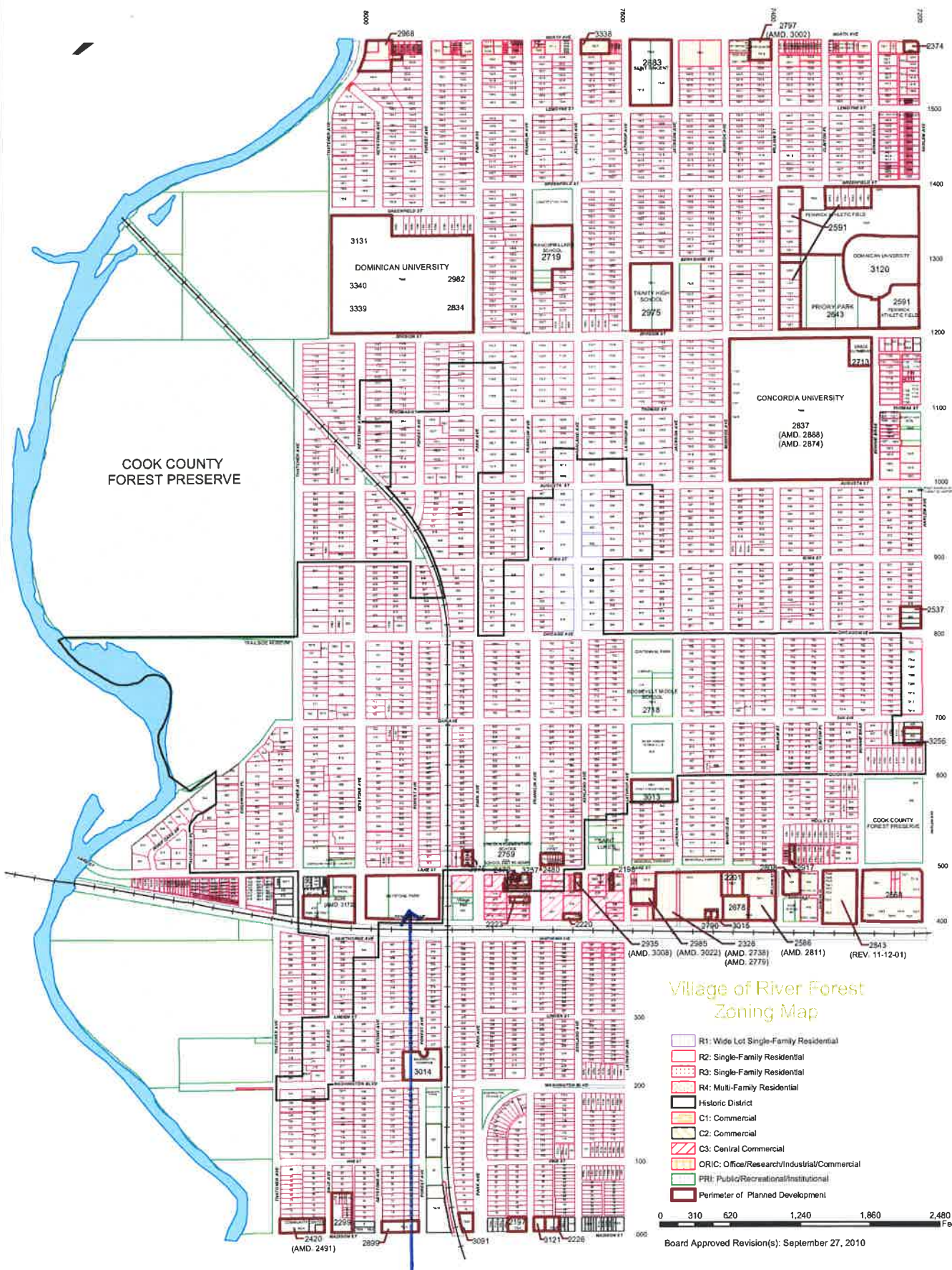

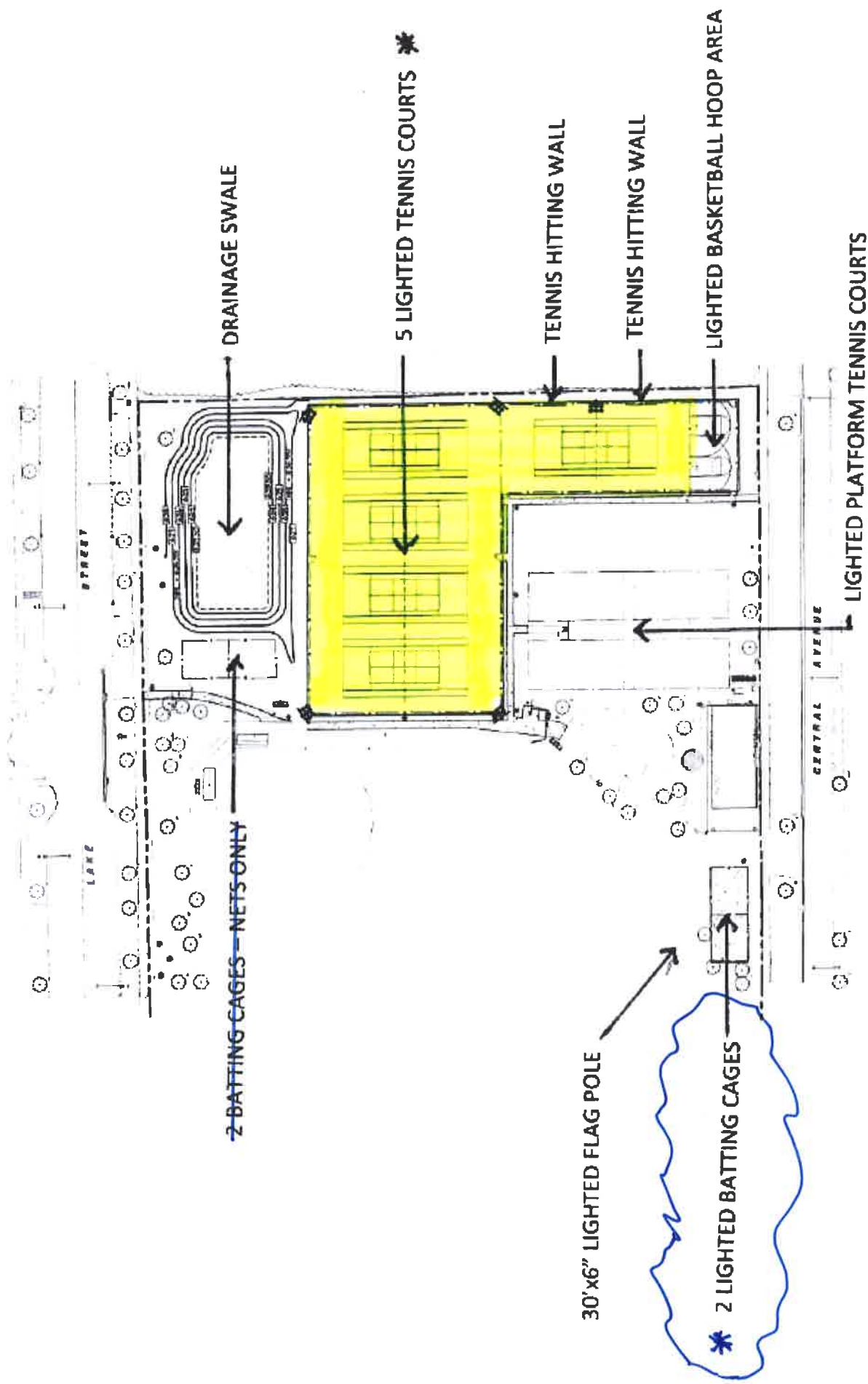


Village of River Forest Zoning Map

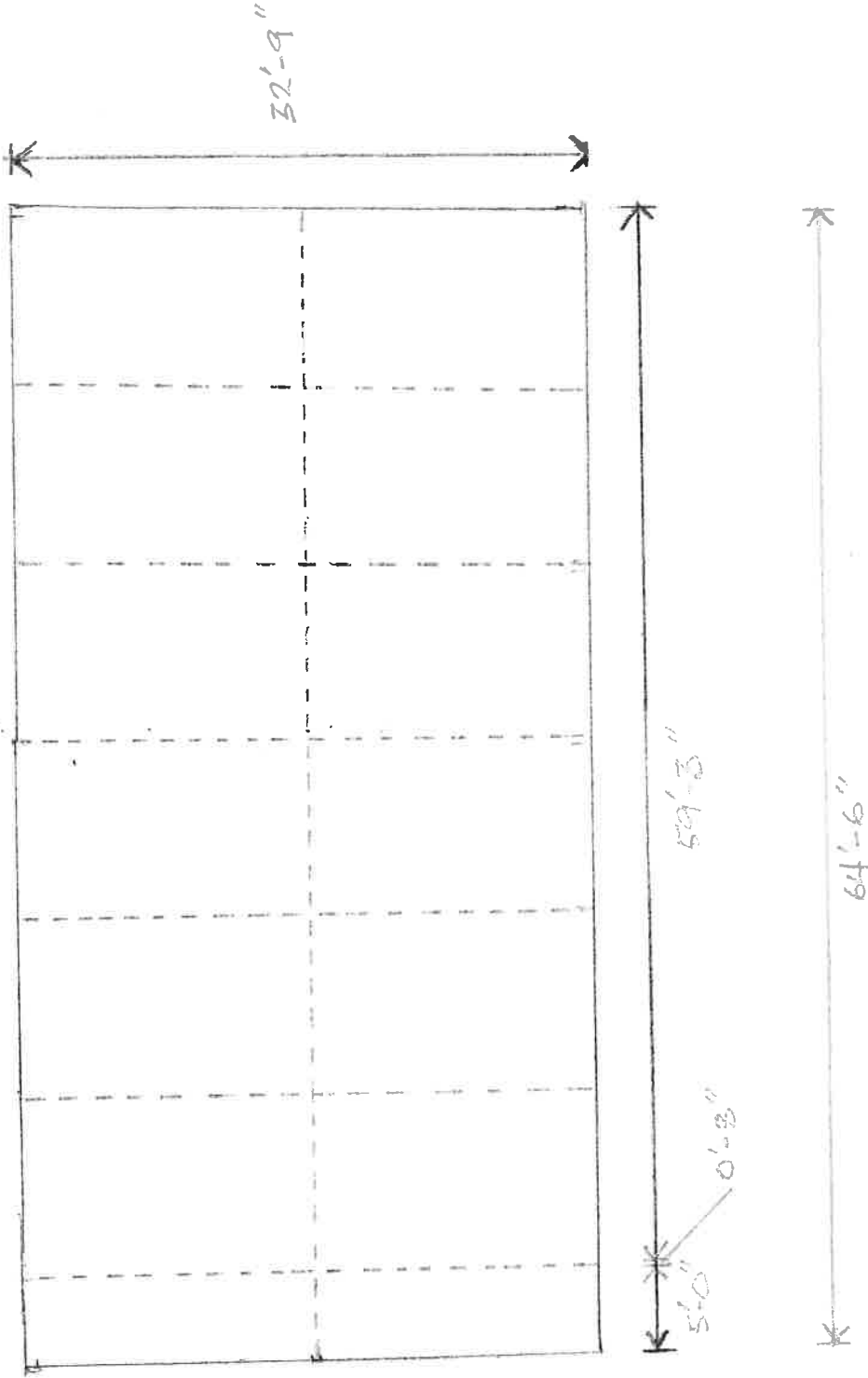

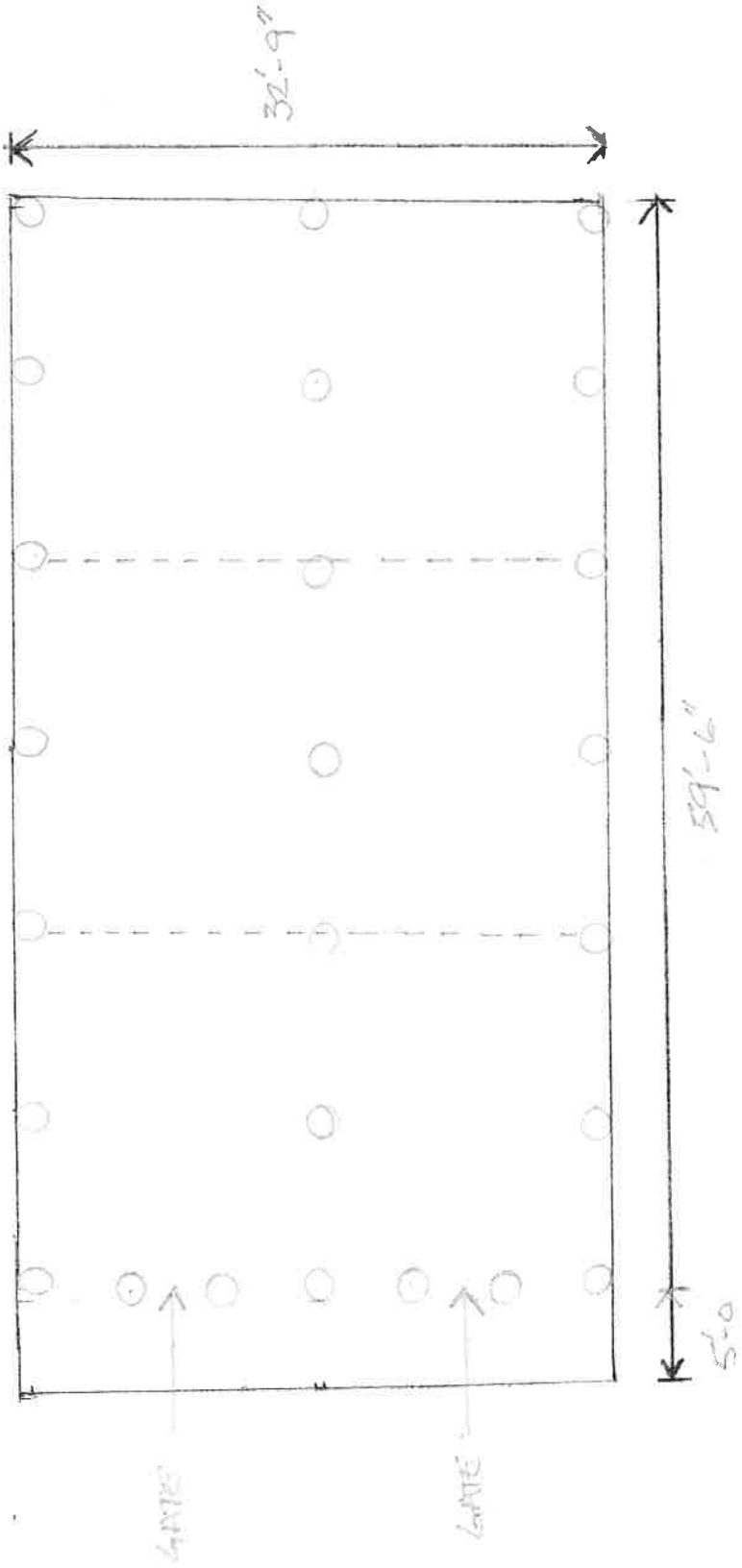
