Drive-Through Pick-up and Drop-Off:

Each campsite will have a drive-through area for camp pick-up and drop-off. During camp drop-off, campers will be asked to stay in their car until a designated staff member safely signs them in. The sign-in procedure will include a "Symptom Checker". Campers who are experiencing any symptoms listed on the checklist, will not be allowed to attend camp.

Symptom Checker:

- 1) Does the camper have a fever? Campers should take their temperatures every day before camp.
- 2) Does the camper have chills?
- 3) Does the camper have shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
- 4) Does the camper have muscle pain?
- 5) Does the camper have new loss of taste or smell?
- 6) Has the camper traveled out of the country with family or friends?
- 7) Has the camper been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19?

A face mask must be worn:

- When a 6' distance cannot be maintained
- When indoors at the campsite
- When transitioning between activities
- At pick-up and drop-off
